

NOTICE OF SRSC RACE SERIES

THE 2010 TWILIGHT SERIES

BEGINS MONDAY, JUNE 7, 6:00 pm

Every Monday evening at Lake Ralphine. Skippers meeting at 6:00 pm.

From Monday, June 7, through Monday, August 30

(Boats should have a Lake Ralphine launch permit.)

RACES:

The races will be held as a series of 13 race days. We expect to have 2 races per evening, for a total of 26 races. There is a possibility that the lake will be closed on one of the earlier Mondays in which case we will cancel (thereby shortening the series).

CLASSES:

Boats multiplied by races must equal 3 times 62% of the races completed (48 if all scheduled races are completed) for a class in the series. Boats not having a class will be scored under the current Portsmouth Handicap D-PN.

SCORING:

Scoring will be based on US Sailing 2009-2012 Rules 89.1 and Appendix A11, US Sailing note (Alternative Scoring System for Long Series). To qualify for inclusion in the final series results, a boat shall start in at least 62% of the races completed (16 of 26 if all are raced). A boat not starting will not be scored. Although anyone is welcome to participate, only SRSC members will be eligible for awards recognition.

AFTER RACING:

The social gathering place following the evenings' racing will be at Mary's Restaurant across from Howarth Park about 8:30. We encourage all participants and spectators to join us.
